
Our Values: The Azurity Way

1-Year Medical Affairs Fellowship Description

The one-year Fellowship Program will provide a broad understanding of the various roles and responsibilities within Medical Affairs. The Fellow will be involved in activities that support company goals and will develop and strengthen their knowledge in Medical Affairs. These initiatives include:

- Medical Information: Develop scientifically fair and balanced medical response letters to address unsolicited medical inquires
- Publication Strategy: Train within cross-functional teams to assist with the execution of initiatives throughout a product's lifecycle
- Medical Review: Recognize the roles of Regulatory, Legal, and Medical in Scientific and Promotional Review Committees
- Pharmacovigilance: Familiarize with all aspects of drug safety including reporting adverse events, the MedWatch 3500 form, and aggregate regulatory reports
- Collaboration Across Functional Areas and Vendors: Advise Clinical Development, Regulatory Affairs, Marketing, Sales, Business Development

The Fellow will work closely with members of the Medical Affairs Team. Efforts will be made to account for the interests of the Fellow in developing an individualized program.


